REMINDER

Applying for a Reception place 2018 If you have a child born between 1 September 2013 and 31 August 2014, you will need to apply for a place in a reception class in September 2018 for that child, even if he/she already has an early years or nursery place at your preferred school.

Applying for a Junior School Place 2018 If your child was born between 1 September 2010 and 31 August 2011 and currently attends an infant school, you will need to apply for a place in year three for September 2018.

The deadline for applications is 15 January 2018.
