

We understand the importance of staying safe when we are online. We thought of our own rules and shared these with our buddies.



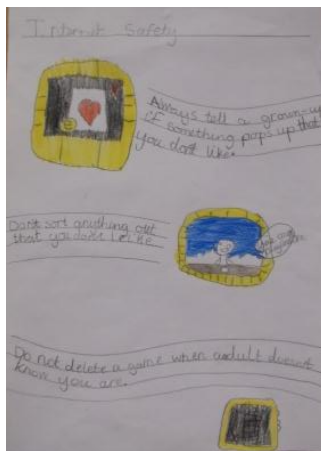
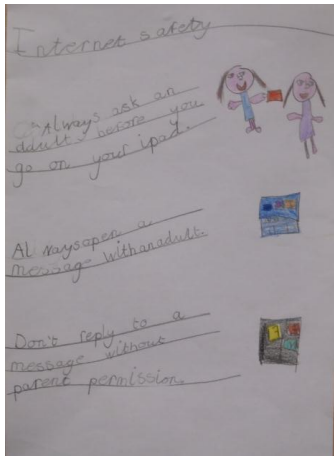
Only open messages if you are with an adult.



Tell an adult if something comes up on your screen that you do not like.



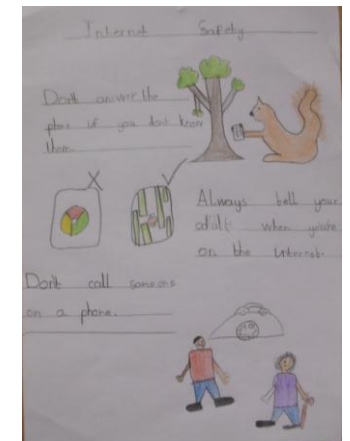
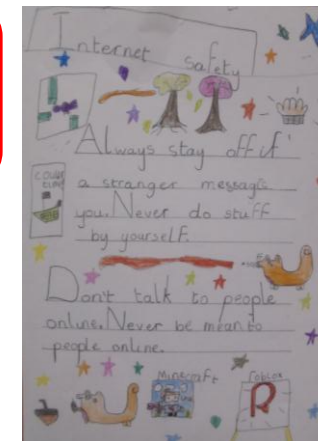
Only click on things that you know are safe for children.
