Under current rules we already have a duty of care to ensure that the data we receive, collect and keep is safe and shared appropriately. GDPR has brought some changes for schools about the way we manage and also report on how we manage the data. Part of this is the appointment of a Data Protection Officer; in our school this will be Mrs Lock and she will be working with Mr Battley, our Governor with specific responsibility for 'Data Protection'.
