We are very independent; we pour our own drinks and select our snacks.

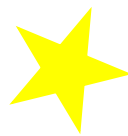
We have looked closely at our reflections in the mirror to help us create our self-portraits.



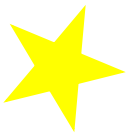
We listen carefully during phonics time and have been create patterns of sound with percussion instruments.



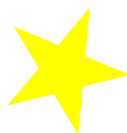
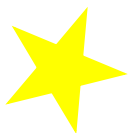
We have shared the story 'Only One You', it has helped us to think about what makes us special and what are our wishes...

We were so excited when our Magic wand asked us to go on an adventure to find him and make our nursery his home!



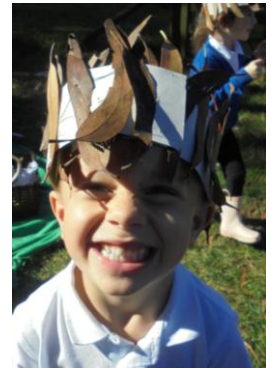
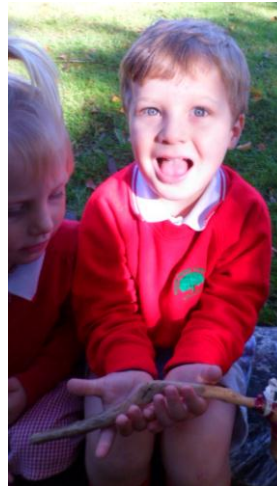
We found sparkles and arrows!!
