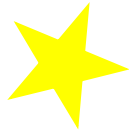
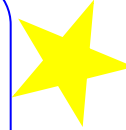


We have had a wonderful term travelling the journey of our Magic Wand and developing all areas of our learning...

We can recognise and name 2D shapes and have discussed their properties.

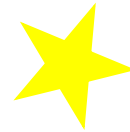


The Magic Wand soared over the flowing path of the mighty river...he flew over the large bridge...

We love to listen to and retell our Three Billy Goats story. We each play a different character during our role play.



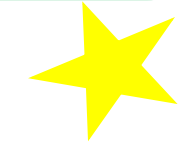
We have used non-standard units to measure the length of world famous bridges.

We have talked about our family traditions and how we are each preparing for Christmas in our homes.



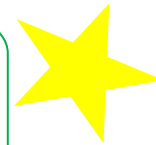
We have learnt the Christmas Story. We like to dress up and act out the story as different characters.

We have used our scissor skills to cut parts and used glue to join to make our Rudolph or polar bear Christmas cards.



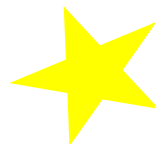
