

# We have had a great half-term in EYFS2 and we have all ploughed through so much learning!

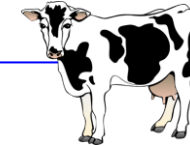
We have learnt to write super sentences. We always remember capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.



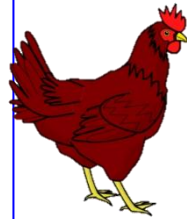
We researched different farm animals and recorded the facts we know.



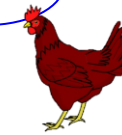
We followed step by step guides to learn to draw different farm animals.



During our daily phonics we have begun to learn to segment and blend sounds to read CVC words.



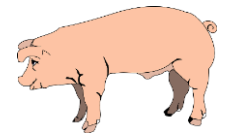
We have learnt to add and take away numbers, using numicon, number lines and practical objects.

We used a range of materials to make our class Poppy wreaths.

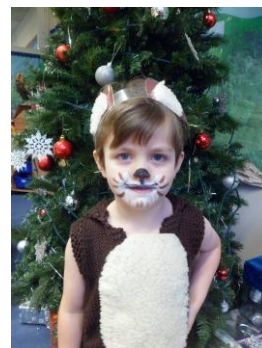


## Remembrance Day
