LISKEARD & LOOE FOODBANK HELPING LOCAL PEOPLE IN CRISIS

We attended a very interesting meeting at St James Church on Thursday night about our local foodbank. Although originating in Liskeard and Looe it supports families in Torpoint and the Rame Peninsula as well.

As a school we will be organising an event to support the food bank later in the school year as there are several points through the year when need for help increases.

If as a family you would like to give now, at the time when giving is at the forefront of our minds, there are donation boxes in the local supermarket's, costcutters or in the churches.

The foodbank website <https://liskeardlooe.foodbank.org.uk/> contains up to date information about donations that they would most appreciate. Currently this includes

- meat (tinned) ham, corned beef etc
- treats/snacks
- deodorants (male/female)
- vegetables (tinned) potatoes, carrots, peas etc
- steamed pudding

They also always need the following less obvious items

- Nappies
- baby food
- toiletries
- toilet roll
- tin openers
- sanitary products

Their website also contains details of how to give a regular donation to cover some of the hidden costs of providing such a valuable community service.


