We learnt how to build a fire and then toasted marshmallows to make s'mores. We talked about how to stay safe around a fire.



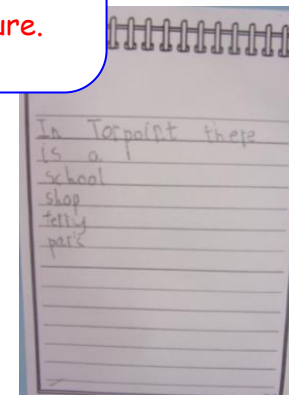
We worked together in teams. We made dens in the wildlife area and used natural materials to make artwork.



We have been 3D shape explorers, finding 3D shapes around the classroom! We know their names and some of their properties.



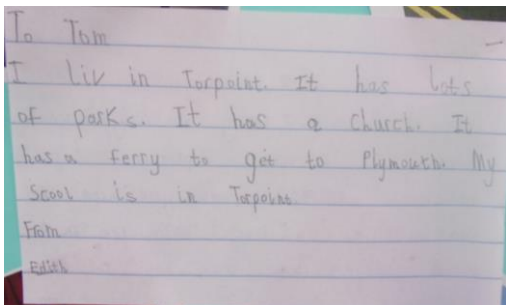
We have been using our phonics to write lists showing all the things explorers need to pack for an adventure.
