We designed and made our own bug hotels using a range of natural materials. We carried out a scientific test to find out which material would make a strong and waterproof outer layer for our bug hotels.



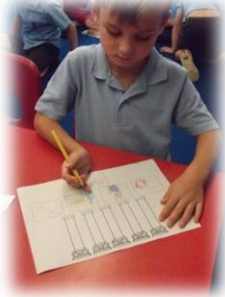
We learnt all about Islam and the traditions they follow. We looked at special places of worship from different religions.
